

Encanto Valley Farm LLC Horse Show Rules & Etiquette

In order for the business of Encanto Valley Farm LLC (“EVF”) to continue evolving into a professional, productive, fun environment the following rules will be implemented immediately:

- ☀ All questions, comments and concerns should be presented to the LLC’s Co-Manager, Morgan Carr, in a timely, professional manner. Even though, this is an individual sport, EVF and each participant in a horse show are a TEAM. Please remember, that as a team member, EVF supports each and every team member throughout every horse show. Also remember, that other teams are always observing our actions and we will be much more successful as a supportive, united team.
- ☀ You are responsible for yourself and your horse. This includes, and is not limited to, knowing when you and/or your horse should be in the warm-up arena and/or show arena. Morgan will put up an estimated daily schedule on the white board, and the show office always has day sheets for your use. Feel free to ask Morgan questions regarding the schedule; however the ultimate responsibility belongs to you. You are responsible for making sure your horse is at the appropriate arena for any pro rides. If you are not going to be at the show during your horse’s pro rides, please make the necessary arrangements with Morgan.
- ☀ Remember you are an athlete. Treat your body accordingly. Healthy meals and proper rest make for a more successful show. The choices you make not only impact you, but the team as well.
- ☀ Horse Equipment Requirements:
 - You are responsible for supplying and properly marking all: boots, saddle pads, bridles, girths, saddles, martingales, etc. Girths can be marked with permanent pen. Bridles/martingales, etc should have either a small brass tag with your name or initials engraved on it.
 - Once you and Morgan have decided on the appropriate bit, please plan on purchasing your own bit to keep on your own bridle.
 - Equipment (when not in use) should be stored clean in a locking tack trunk. Make sure Morgan has either a spare key or the combination to your trunk.
 - The above Horse Equipment Requirements do not apply to sale horses.
- ☀ Horse Showing is a chance to demonstrate all of the hard work that you and your horse have been doing at home. Anything less than a “can do” attitude will not be allowed or condoned. EVF and Morgan reserve the right to privately discuss that any individual not representing the EVF team appropriately, refrain from showing for a specified period of time.

- ✿ EVF does not require, at this time, that a parent attend with their minor child, providing that a guardian has been assigned, and travel arrangements have been made. If a minor demonstrates, that he or she can not travel responsibly alone, it will become mandatory that a parent attends all horse shows with this minor going forward.
- ✿ EVF requests that everyone representing the EVF team dresses appropriately. Please remember that you are not just representing yourself, but the team you ride for and with. EVF and Morgan reserve the right to request that you change into more appropriate attire.
- ✿ EVF allows team members to bring their dogs to the shows (assuming dogs are allowed on show grounds). However, the dog needs to stay in the team member's care the entire day. If the team member is showing, the dog will either need to go in the team member's stall or be assigned to someone else to hold. At no time, should a dog be tied up in a tack room, under the awning, or to a tack trunk. Lizzie is exempt from this rule.
- ✿ The EVF horse show area needs to remain picked up and organized. All loose clothing, shoes, personal items need to be put away in a tack trunk. All garbage must be disposed of immediately.
- ✿ Minors may not consume alcohol at anytime.
